Policy on Research Incentives

Preamble

Research is an important and an integral component of the mission of **JAIN (Deemed-to-be University)**. A clearly laid down policy on research incentives is an important means of promoting and sustaining the research culture in our University. Further, such a policy will help recognize and reward good quality research output of faculty members. The objective of this document is to establish the guiding principles for recognizing quality research output. **JAIN (Deemed-to-be University)** hereinafter referred to as **JAIN (Deemed-to-be University)** hereby provides the necessary framework of research incentives conforming to the following tenets:

- **JAIN** encourages varying points of view, inquiry, thought and expressions free of ideology or coercions of any type for the benefit of mankind.
- **JAIN** members engaged in Research are open to select topics/domains in their area of competence or in collaboration with other faculty members, seek financial assistance from genuine sources with the approval of the **JAIN (Deemed-to-be University)** and be solely responsible for their outcome and conclusions.
- **JAIN** shall attempt to provide an atmosphere conducive to undertaking Research to all interested and motivated faculty to undertake the same.
- **JAIN** shall sensitize all concerned to ensure authorship rights & responsibilities of students, co-investigators and others associated with the research outcome. **JAIN** shall conduct regular surveys to verify on academic authorship of any publication with regard to the research outcomes.
- **JAIN** affirms to provide research opportunities to all concerned without bias to gender, caste, creed, religion and race.
- **JAIN** advocates the philosophy of shared ownership of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) with regard to all scholarly pursuits.
- This policy on Research Incentives is subject to review by the Research Committee of the **JAIN**, constituted whose composition is indicated in **ANNEXURE I**. The **JAIN** may update and announce any detailed implementing procedure(s) on this policy from time to time as necessary. Any revision in the policy shall be announced publicly through the **JAIN** website and /or other suitable means.

1. Applicability of the Policy on Research Incentives

This policy shall apply to:

- Full time Teaching Faculty Members of the JAIN, Faculty Members of the JAIN involved in full time research and adjunct faculty.
- Publications by JAIN members in:
 - Scopus indexed journals
 - Web of Sciences (Science Citation index, Social Science Citation index, Arts & Humanities Citation index)
 - UGC approved list of Journals (other than those already indexed in Scopus and Web of Science)
- Research projects funded by external agencies exceeding Rs.10 lakhs in value.
- Research papers published with JAIN affiliation.

2. Relevant Period / Effective Date

- The relevant period shall be the calendar year for research publications and financial year for projects.
- The effective date for research publications shall be the date of publication online.

3. Members eligible for incentives

- Full time teaching faculty members of the JAIN: This refers to teaching faculty employed in Schools of the JAIN offering UG / PG programmes who have the teaching workload as specified by JAIN from time to time.
- Adjunct faculty: This refers to teaching faculty employed in Schools of the JAIN offering UG / PG programmes for a specified number of days in a week, who have the teaching workload as specified by JAIN from time to time.
- Faculty Members of the JAIN involved in full time research: This refers to faculty employed in Research Centres or in the Schools of the University, whose primary responsibility is to procure and deliver output in funded research projects, publication of research papers in reputed journals with a high impact factor, procuring & executing consultancy projects, guiding Ph. D scholars, publication of books and book chapters, filing for patents and commercialization of technology.
- Principal Investigator (PI): This refers to faculty employed in Schools / Research Centre of the JAIN who procures an externally funded- project.
- Co-Investigator (Co-PI): Each project shall necessarily have a Co-investigator, who complements the PI and the CO-PI must be from JAIN.

4. Publications in Scopus / Web of Science indexed journals

- Scopus is a bibliographic database containing abstracts and citations for academic journal articles. It covers nearly 22,000 titles from over 5,000 publishers, of which 20,000 are peer-reviewed journals in the scientific, technical, medical, and social sciences.
- The Web of Science platform connects the Web of Science Core Collection to regional citation indexes, patent data, specialized subject indexes, and an index of research data sets, all in all totalling over 33,000 journals.

5. Publications in Journals included in UGC- CARE List Group-(I) other than in Scopus / Web of Science Indexed journals.

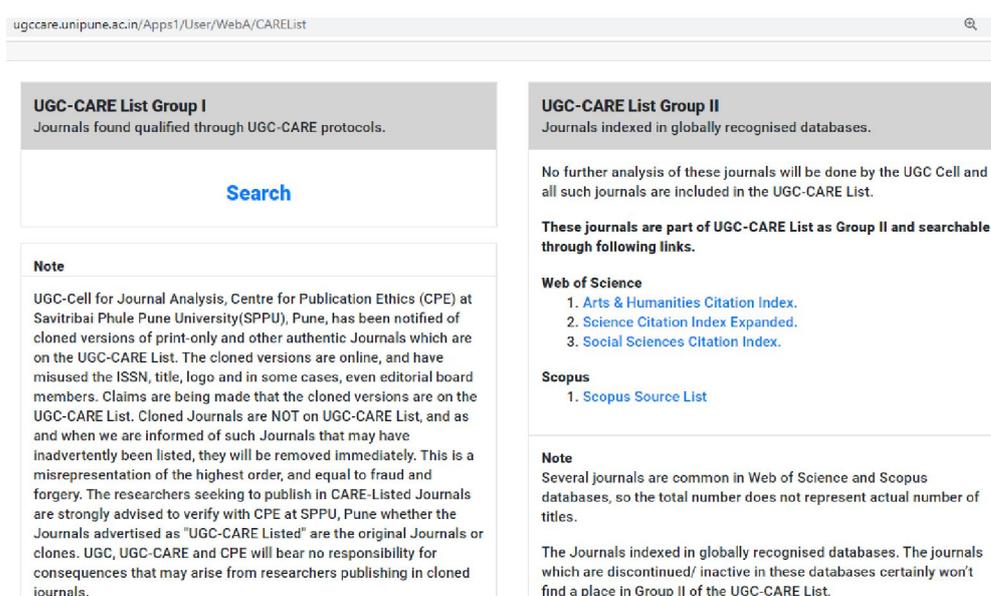

6. Validation Process

- The JAIN (Deemed-to-be University) shall follow the following validation process while evaluating research papers:

For publications listed in Scopus / Web of Sciences databases

- Reference shall be made to the UGC CARE database (Group-II) of approved journals (“<https://ugccare.unipune.ac.in/Apps1/User/WebA/CAREList>”)

The cloned versions are online, and have misused the ISSN, title, logo and in some cases, even editorial board members. Claims are being made that the cloned versions are on the UGC-CARE List. Cloned Journals are NOT on UGC-CARE List, and as and when we are informed of such Journals that may have inadvertently been listed, they will be removed immediately. This is a misrepresentation of the highest order, and equal to fraud and forgery. The researchers seeking to publish in CARE-Listed Journals are strongly advised to verify with CPE at SPPU, Pune whether the Journals advertised as "UGC-CARE Listed" are the original Journals or clones. UGC, UGC-CARE and CPE will bear no responsibility for consequences that may arise from researchers publishing in cloned journals.

The Journals indexed in globally recognised databases. The journals which are discontinued/ inactive in these databases certainly won't find a place in Group II of the UGC-CARE List.

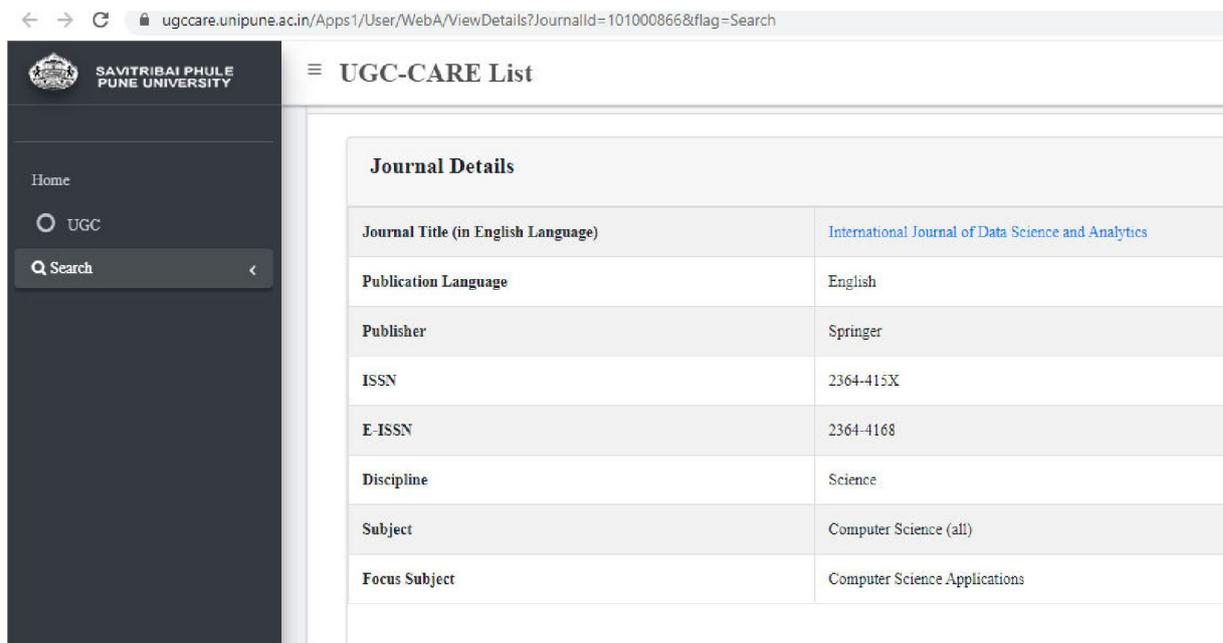

7. Award of Incentives for research papers.

a. Publication in journals indexed in Scopus/ Web of Science databases by Full Time Teaching Faculty Members of the University and Adjunct Faculty.

The incentives shall be as follows:

- Research papers published in Scopus / Web of Science databases with **SNIP / JIF** (Journal Impact Factor) score between 0.5 and 1.0 : Rs 5,000/- per paper.
- Research papers published in Scopus / Web of Science databases with **SNIP / JIF** score between 1.01 and 2.99 : Rs 10,000/- per paper.
- Research papers published in Scopus / Web of Science databases with **SNIP / JIF** score above 3.0 : Rs 15,000/- per paper.
- In the event of single author research papers, the full amount shall be paid to the author.
- In the event of two authors, the corresponding author will get 60% and the other author, the balance.

- In the event of multiple contributors for a research paper, the said amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First Author 40%; Corresponding Author 30%; Remaining contributors 30% to be shared equally. If the corresponding author coordinates a research project on which the said article is based, the sharing will be the First Author 30%; Corresponding Author 40%; Remaining Contributors 30% to be shared equally.
- In the event the first author is also the corresponding author, then the amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First (and corresponding) author 40% and Remaining contributors 60%, to be shared equally.
- In the event the JAIN member publishes a research paper in collaboration with authors affiliated to other Institutions, then the JAIN member will get 30% of the defined incentive.

Note:

For the full time teaching faculty members, incentives shall be applicable provided the member publishes more than one research paper per year. In such cases, each research paper in excess of one shall attract the above said incentives.

b. Publication in journals indexed in Scopus/ Web of Science databases by Faculty Members of the JAIN involved in full time research in Research Centres / Schools of the JAIN

In respect of such faculty members, incentives shall be applicable provided the member publishes more than 4 research papers with a minimum cumulative impact factor of 8 per year in Scopus / Web of Science indexed database. In such cases, where the number of papers exceed 4, each paper shall attract incentives as follows:

- SNIP / JIF score above 5 and below 8 : Rs 5,000/-
- SNIP / JIF score above 8 and below 10 : Rs 7,000/-
- SNIP / JIF score above 10 and below 15 : Rs 15,000/-
- SNIP / JIF score above 15 and below 20 : Rs 30,000/-
- SNIP / JIF score above 20 and below 25 : Rs 50,000/-

- SNIP / JIF score above 25 and below 30 : Rs 75,000/-
- SNIP / JIF score above 30 : Rs 100,000/-
- In addition to the above, they will be eligible for incentives based on the cumulative impact achieved during the year in Scopus/ Web of Sciences indexed journals, this will be only applicable if the cumulative impact factor exceeds 8. The incentive scale is given in **Annexure - II**.
- In the event of single author research papers, the full amount shall be paid to the author.
- In the event of two authors, the corresponding author will get 60% and the other author, the balance.
- In the event of multiple contributors for a research paper, the said amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First Author 40%; Corresponding Author 30%; Remaining contributors 30% to be shared equally. If the corresponding author coordinates a research project on which the said article is based, the sharing will be the First Author 30%; Corresponding Author 40%; Remaining Contributors 30% to be shared equally.
- In the event the first author is also the corresponding author, then the amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First (and corresponding) author 40% and Remaining contributors 60%, to be shared equally.
- In the event the **JAIN** member publishes a research paper in collaboration with authors affiliated to other Institutions, then the **JAIN** member will get 30% of the defined incentive.

c. Publication in UGC-CARE listed Journals under Group-(I) (other than those indexed in Scopus/ Web of Science databases) by Full Time Teaching Faculty Members of the JAIN and Adjunct Faculty.

The incentives shall be as follows:

- Research papers published in UGC- CARE Journals database Group-(I) (other than those indexed in Scopus/ Web of Science databases): Rs 5,000/- per paper.
- In the event of single author research papers, the full amount shall be paid to the author.

- In the event of two authors, the corresponding author will get 60% and the other author, the balance.
- In the event of multiple contributors for a research paper, the said amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First Author 40%; Corresponding Author 30%; Remaining contributors 30% to be shared equally. If the corresponding author coordinates a research project on which the said article is based, the sharing will be the First Author 30%; Corresponding Author 40%; Remaining Contributors 30% to be shared equally.
- In the event the first author is also the corresponding author, then the amount shall be shared in the following proportion: First (and corresponding) author 40% and Remaining contributors 60%, to be shared equally.
- In the event the JAIN member publishes a research paper in collaboration with authors affiliated to other Institutions, then the JAIN member will get 30% of the defined incentive.

8. Award of Incentives for externally funded projects..

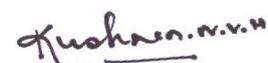
Externally funded projects awarded by Faculty Members of the JAIN involved in full time research in Research Centres / Schools of the JAIN.

In the event a faculty member is awarded projects amounting to Rs 10 lakhs and above in value during an academic year (July- June), he /she shall be eligible for an incentive of 5% of the total fund received by PI and shall be released based on the installment received by JAIN during the year.

In the event of the PI leaving the services of the JAIN before completing the project, the incentive amount paid to him/her shall be refunded by the PI to the University and the project handed over to the Co-investigator. In such a case, the Co-Investigator shall be eligible for the said incentive.

Conclusion:

It is expected that the research output of the JAIN will increase manifold with the implementation of the proposed scheme. The faculty members of Schools / Research Centers will be motivated to actively take part in the pursuit of outcome based research initiatives of the JAIN (Deemed-to-be University).
