REGULATIONS GOVERNING ADMISSIONS, ATTENDANCE, ASSESSMENT AND EXAMINATIONS OF SPORTS-PERSONS IN JAIN UNIVERSITY

- 1. Short Title: These Regulations shall be called "JAIN University Sports Regulations"
- 2. The JAIN University has the power under Section 2.6 sub-sections (2) and (4) of the Jain University Act to make regulations for admission of students into the University, their attendance, assessment and examinations.
- 3. The Regulations for admissions, attendance, assessment and examinations of sports persons in Jain University are given in the subsequent paras and shall apply, subject to modifications from time to time. The regulations thus made shall further the policy of the University to encourage talented students to bring laurels to the University, the State, the Country and to humanity at large.

Admissions:

4. The following criteria shall be adopted during admission of candidates to various courses/programmes of the University:

a) U.G. Courses:

The candidates who have represented their Higher Secondary Schools / Junior Colleges in the PUC Board / State / National level sports / games events recognized by State / National level sports Associations / Federations can be considered for admission on preferential basis provided they possess minimum eligibility criteria imposed by University Regulations for the Courses for which they seek admissions.

b) P.G. Courses:

The candidates who have represented any University in inter - university sports / games events / the State in National level events / the Nation in International events recognized by the accredited and authorized sports Associations / Federations can be considered for admissions on preferential basis. A relaxation of 5% marks shall be given in the Eligibility condition on minimum percentage of total marks obtained in the cognate / related subjects in the entire degree course while adhering to all other eligibility criteria for admission imposed by University Regulations. (This relaxation does not apply to SC / ST candidates who are already covered under other relaxation criteria)

In all cases of allotment of seats under this category, relative merit alone shall be the criteria when the number of seats available is less than the number of eligible candidates seeking admission for any Course of study.

Attendance Requirement:

5. A student is eligible to appear for the semester end university examinations, only if he / she has put in a minimum of 75% in each subject individually.

Condonation of shortage of attendance shall be given to the candidates who represented the University in sports / games at inter-university / state / national / international levels, on case to case basis, as recommended by the Sports Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

Internal Assessment and University Examinations:

6. The following provisions shall apply to students in this category for Internal Assessment and for University examinations

Internal Assessment:

For the students representing the University in sports / games the Internal Assessment (IA) shall be conducted in two parts:

- a) 50% of the IA marks shall be allotted for a summative assignment submitted by the students in each paper as prescribed by the concerned Faculty member / HoD of the Department of Study and the performance will be evaluated out of this maximum of 50%.
- b) Remaining 50% of the IA marks shall be set aside for the evaluation of the performance of the student representing the University at various levels of sports / games events. The Director of sports, Jain University is responsible for assessing the performance out of this maximum of 50% of IA marks and forwarding the IA marks to the respective Heads of Departments of Study, within the specified date.

University Examination:

The schedule and time- table of any regular / make-up University Examination shall be as applicable to all the students. However, in exceptional cases, at the final Semester of any degree program, a special supplementary examination may be conducted for the benefit of those students who were absent during the scheduled regular / make-up examinations due to their authorized participation in the national / international level sports /games events recognized by the accredited National level Associations / Federations, if such cases are certified and recommended by the Director of Sports, Jain University.

Award of Performance based Grace Marks:

Outstanding sportspersons, selected to represent University / State / National teams in any of the sports / games competitions recognized by National level Associations / Federations, shall be eligible for a maximum grace marks of 4% in each paper in the University examinations.

The quantum of grace marks is directly related to the cumulative performance of the students in the Inter-university level, State level, National level, International level Competitions and shall be governed by the norms prescribed by the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor with the Director of sports as the Convener.
